

SCHOOL CODE OF CONDUCT

SCHOOL POLICY: Respect teachers and students, be considerate and show friendly conduct.

- Smart phones and electronics only to be used during break.
- No running or loud talking in the halls. Show respect to the rooms we are renting and its property. Oftentimes, there is testing going on in the building or other groups meet.
- Any damages sustained to the property will be remedied by the individuals responsible.
- Be punctual.
- Complete your homework.
- No disruptive or distractive behavior.
- No bullying, harassing, words of profanity or obscenity.
- No weapons—guns, knives, sharp objects, or lighters, etc.

CLASSROOM DROP OFF/PICK UP: All students need to be dropped off/picked up from the classroom.

- Students up to fourth grade need to be dropped off and picked up by a parent. No children are allowed to wander or sit in the halls. No one should go into rooms or areas of CLA that are not designated for use by DANK.
- Students need to be picked up in a timely manner. If a parent neglects to be on time, a designated late-fee will be charged.

CLASSROOM RULE: DANK: DENKEN – ACHTEN – NENNEN – KENNEN

DENKEN: I think – Thinking BEFORE speaking or acting is always better. Be considerate, polite and friendly with your teacher and your classmates.

ACHTEN: I respect – Respect and honor goes a long way. Respect your teacher and your classmates.

NENNEN: I participate – Listening to your teacher and be ready to give an answer will help you to learn. Speak when you are supposed to speak, listen when you are supposed to listen.

KENNEN: I understand and value learning. This is how I will learn and master the German language, culture and its people.

CLASSROOM DISCIPLINE: Ongoing disruptive behavior will not be accepted

Parents will be notified of any unacceptable, disruptive behavior on the part of their children and expected to help ensure that this does not become an ongoing problem.

The following action will be taken in the event of any classroom disruption or misbehavior:

1. In the event of any disruptive or distractive behavior on the part of a student, the parent or parents will be notified of the problem in writing and asked to make sure their student understands that this type of behavior will not be tolerated.
2. If the behavioral issues occur again, the parent or parents will be notified in writing of the specific behavioral problems and will be advised that future disruptive occurrences will not be tolerated. Parents are encouraged to arrange a conference with the teacher and school directors to discuss how to ensure that these problems do not continue.
3. In the event that behavioral problems continue, DANK Schools reserve the right to terminate the student's attendance at our Schools without any refund.
